

From the aiport

You can take the bus E4 to Bastion (time table here http://www.ratt.ro/grafice/e4b.pdf) and then from Bastion you have to cross the street and take the bus no.17 to Agromonie - tickets are less than 1 euro

From the train station

If you come from the North Railway Station of the city, you can take the trolleybus no. 14 to Iulius Mall, from where you have the trolleybus no. 17. directly to the campus

Orange and Digi Mobile.


Each carrier offers a wide variety of cell phones, and students can choose from different pre-pay plans ("pay as you go" plans).








The city public transportation in Timisoara is assured by the Company for Public Transportation Timisoara STPT timetables here www.ratt.ro



The International Airport "Traian Vuia" is situated at 12 km North-East distance from the centre of Timisoara.

The connection between Timişoara and the Traian Vuia Airport is assured by Bus Expres 4



The North Railway Station (Gara de Nord) is the main railway station of the city, at only 15 minutes away from the campus



The vaporettos (electric boats) runs on the Bega river as public transport from Monday to Sunday, according to a fixed timetable, which varies throughout the year, depending on the season.

Health Care



Medical Center for Medico-Social Unit is on the ground floor of the dorm no.3 on main campus. The residence permit

After entering Romania, you must obtain a residence permit. It certifies your right to stay in Romania and you can obtain it from the territorial units of the General Inspectorate for Immigration from the county where you live. In order to obtain a residence permit, you will submit personally a number of documents at least 30 days before the expiry of the right to stay granted by the visa. You also have the possibility to submit the documents through the online service, available at https://portaligi.mai.gov.ro/portaligi/
In order to extend the right of residence (obtaining the residence permit) for studies, you must submit the following documents:

Passport in original

Copy after your passport

Copy after the tenancy contract from the dormitory

Tenancy Contract in original

Medical certificate

Certificate from the educational institution

Application

Explore the surroundings

Rivers, Karsts & Spas between the Danube and the Carpathians

One of the best assets of the region is its stunning natural beauty. In the surroundings of Timișoara (up to 200 km) you can find more national and natural parks, as well as countless natural reserves. They cover huge areas, starting from the rugged mountain peaks of the Carpathians going over 2500 meters in height, down to the wild landscape of the "Iron Gates" of the Danube, Europe's longest river gorge.



The great gorge of the Danube makes up about 130 km of the region's southern border. In places, the river bed narrows from 4 km to only 200 meters, shadowed by limestone walls 250 meters high. This spectacular landscape is one of Europe's "must-see" spots.

North of it two other national parks – Semenic - Cheile Carașului and Nera-Beușnița, respectively, preserve a typical karst area, abounding in gorges, caves and waterfalls.

The south part of the Banat includes also the Baile Herculane resort, set in the lovelly Cerna Valley. It is one of the oldest spa resorts in the world - already used by the romans, 2000 years ago and also beloved by the famous Sissi, who visited it no less than five times.


